- 1. Photographers may enter in one of three classes:
 - (1) Junior Class: up to age 13 (2) Intermediate Class: 14-18 (3) Senior Class: 19 & over

Winning Photos will be sold in a silent auction with proceeds going to Central Missouri Ag Club.

- 2. An entry fee of \$5.00 per artist for up to two (2) pieces will apply. Make checks payable to Central Missouri Ag Club. Deliver images to Pettis County Extension Center at 1012A Thompson Blvd, Sedalia. If you cannot deliver your work during 8:00am 4:30pm, please make arrangements to have someone else deliver your work. Entries must be received by 4:30 pm on Thursday, January 25, 2018. There will be no extension of deadline unless prior arrangements have been made with the club. If shipping, ship prepaid to arrive by January 25 to the above mentioned address. If return shipment is requested, a \$25 handling fee is due upon receipt of the work. Make checks or money orders payable to CMAC. DO NOT SEND CASH. DO NOT USE PACKING PEANUTS.
- 3. Exhibitors may submit two (2) entries. Photography may be any size up to 11"x14" and must be mounted on 11"x14" stiff board. Overall finished size must be 11"x14". Matting is permitted. No frames or hanging materials are permitted. Work not meeting these requirements will not be eligible for contest.
- 4. Entrants will retain copyright of their imagery at all times and will always be credited alongside their picture.
- 5. All images must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have been published elsewhere or have a won a prize in any other photographic competition. Images must have been made within the last year.
- 6. The entrant warrants that they have obtained permission of those pictured in the image (or, where the image shows any persons under 18, the consent of their parent/guardian) for the usage rights required by the competition and will indemnify the Central Missouri Ag Club against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement.
- 7. The photographer must be the sole author and owner of the copyright of the photographs entered into the competition. CMAC respects photographers rights and does not claim copyright for the images you submit to this contest. Photographers will retain full copyright in each entry.

- 8. By entering the Central Missouri Ag Club Photo Contest, each contestant agrees that CMAC may publish his or her captioned photograph in a calendar and exhibit, copy, publish, or otherwise use his or her entry photograph and other entry materials for any purpose, in any media, in perpetuity, without limitation or additional permission or compensation, except where prohibited by law.
- 9. You hereby grant Central Missouri Ag Club a non-exclusive, irrevocable license in each Entry for the above mentioned uses for 3 years following the date of announcement of the winner, thereafter the image may be used for archival purposes only by CMAC.

Following Rules based on Missouri 4-H Photography Guidelines

- 10. Altering (editing to change the contents of a photo) <u>is not permitted for the Central Missouri Ag Club</u> Photo Contest. Examples include adding a sunset or object, removing someone from the shot, airbrushing to cover a bad complexion, etc.
- 11. Enhancing (editing to enhance the existing qualities of a photo) is permitted. Examples include cropping, color temperature change, brightness/contrast adjustments and red-eye reduction.
